Panel presentation

Public security and personal safety may be ensured by institutional collaboration at national level, as well as by cooperation as a responsible entity at European and global level.

For public safety to be perceived, felt at a personal level as a state of tranquility and preserved for as long as possible in local communities, in the micro-groups to which we belong, it is necessary to be aware of economic, social, educational, family-related, religious factors that might cause risk-situations at a local, regional or international level.

The preparation of legal rules aimed at protecting important values for humanity by following the changes in societies, the knowledge of fundamental values necessary for the existence of life on Earth, as well as respect for personal rights and liberties are essential for setting up the preconditions of a social order in the context of which individual safety will be experienced. Risks, threats, criminal offenses, illegal behaviors manifest themselves in various forms, being identified, assessed, criminalized differently depending on the preferences of legislators in different countries. As a result, the investigation thereof will also be carried out through different evidentiary procedures, sometimes requiring knowledge of the technical means used, of the process of exploitation of traces, of the internal rules to be observed and of the forms of intelligence to be used in the process of documentation of the facts provided for by criminal law or in the prevention or combating of criminal offenses. Last but not least, knowledge of legal rules and awareness of sanctions at a theoretical level, a thorough analysis of the penalties enforced and the understanding of systemic mechanisms are important in the process of building social capital.

In the context of the conference on the topic of Public Safety and the Need for Increased Social Capital, we intend, through the topics to be integrated in the panel, to present the strategies undertaken in the field of artificial intelligence incorporating benchmarks to be complied with at a macro-existential level and/or which have generated substantial changes that either removed systemic customs, or generated the process preparation of rules indicating the conduct to be followed.

The specific objectives pursued by us include, among other things, the presentation of the Framework Convention of the Council of Europe on artificial intelligence, of the first AI Regulation in the world, of the National Strategy for the use of Artificial Intelligence 2024-2027, as well as the provision of examples regarding the manner in which Artificial Intelligence may be used in practice.
